- A Long barcode attribute index (default = 0)
- I Default in-date (default = 1980-01-01)
- L Library Repository-ID (default = LIBR)
- M Dump Mode (default = false)
- O Offsite Repository-ID (default = OFFS)
- d Import definition file (default = default.ttidef)
- f output file
