

TMSS10IRM_Reconcile

Synopsis

```
TMSS10IRM_Reconcile [-I iron mountain accounts] [-S logon string] [-U date  
format] [-m customer mapping file] [-n number of records to skip]
```

Description

Processes an Iron Mountain inventory file and produces a TapeTrack scan file to be used for reconciliation.

Options

- -I Iron Mountain account inclusions (default = *)
- -S The logon string argument sets the [Server logon information](#).
- -U Dates are in MMDDYYYY (US) format not DDMMYYYY (default = false)
- -m [Customer Mapping File](#), used to map Iron Mountain account numbers to TapeTrack Customer-ID's (default = NULL)
- -n Number of records at beginning of Inventory File to skip=1

<sxh> TMSS10IRM_Reconcile -S user:-password@server -U -m "mapping.txt" </sxh>
```
