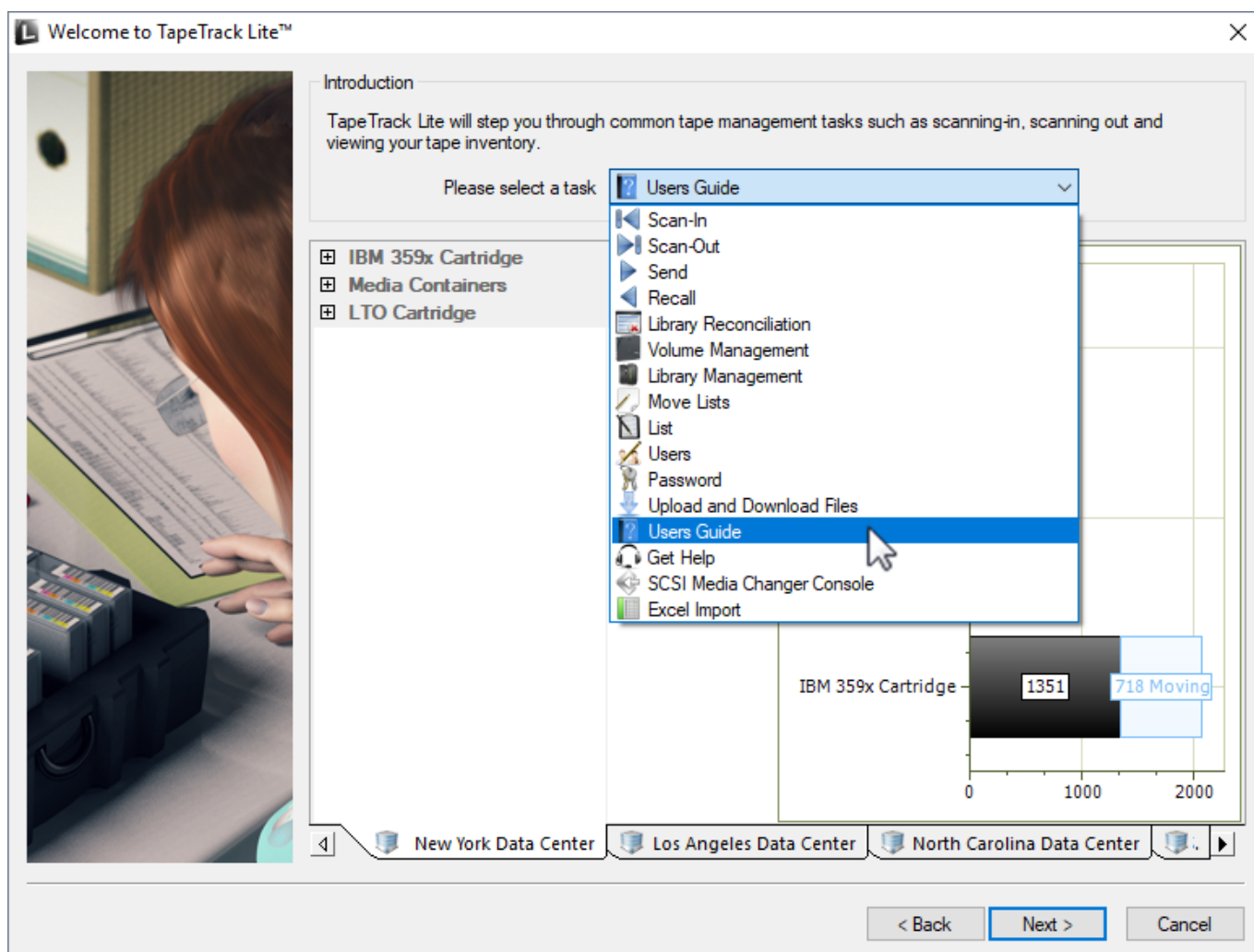


Users Guide

Selecting Users Guide will open up documentation to help guide you through TapeTrack Lite tasks and functions.

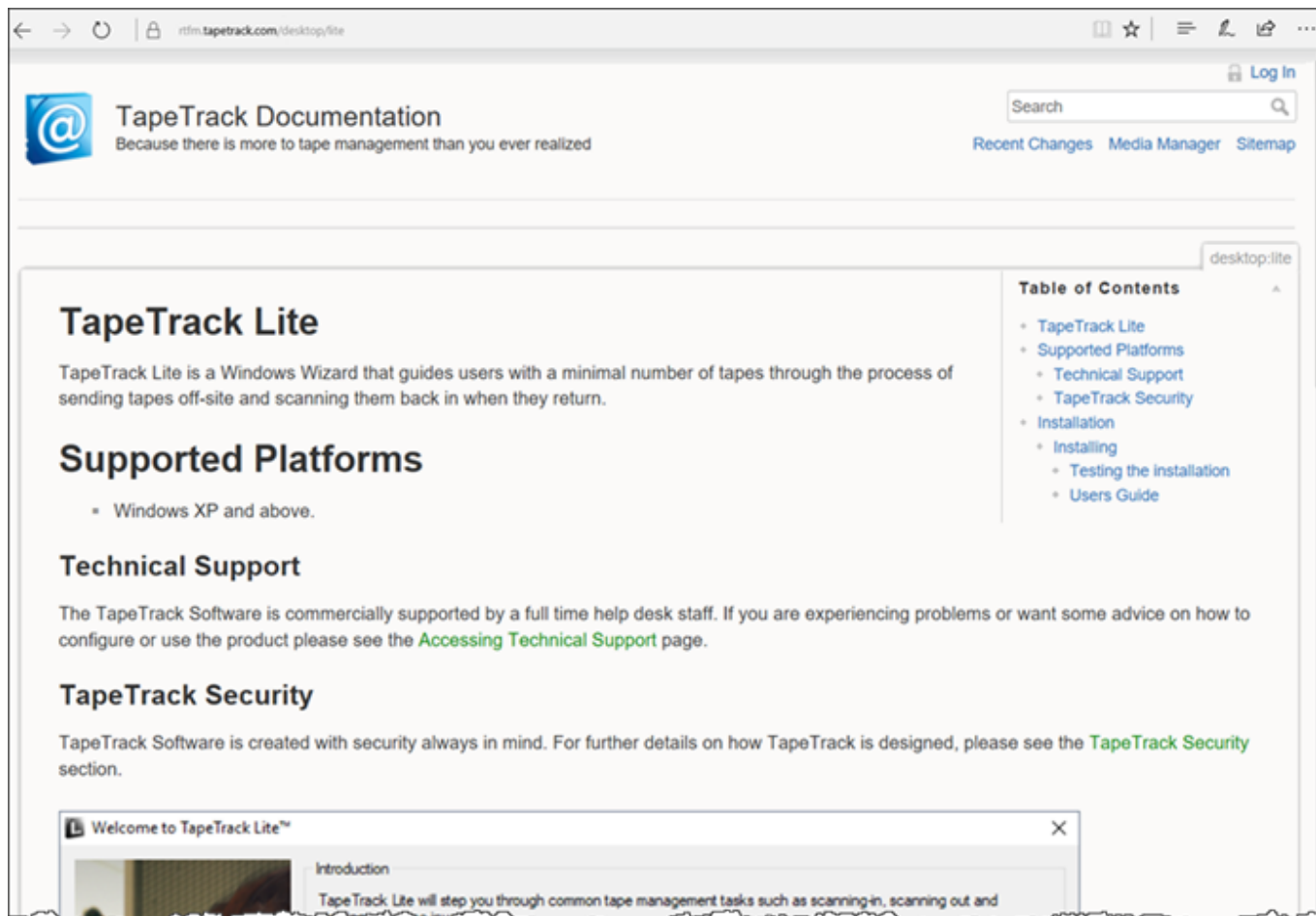
Select Users Guide

Once you have logged into TapeTrack Lite, select "Users Guide" from the Library Management Tasks drop-down menu.



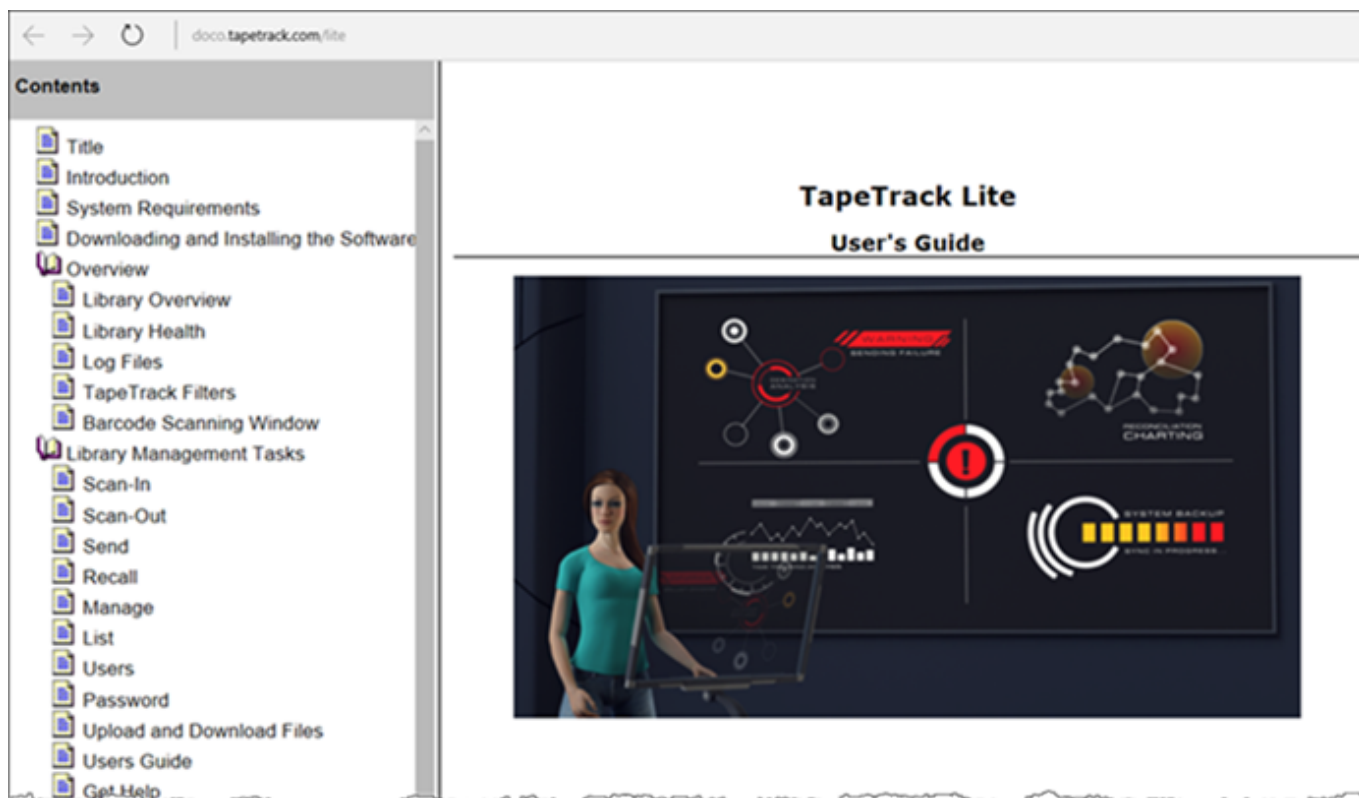
Users Guide option is hidden by default. Edit TMSSLite.cfg file, change Guide to false and restart TapeTrack Lite
