

Journal Entry

A Journal Entry is a Customer-level record written to the TapeTrack Journal database.

Journal Entries can be used to record Customer activity that is not represented by a normal Volume movement or storage transaction.

For billing, a Journal Entry can represent a chargeable service such as:

- Express delivery.
- Overnight delivery.
- Immediate delivery.
- Special handling.
- Emergency retrieval.
- Additional administration.
- Other Customer-specific services.

Journal Entries are identified by a Journal Note Type index. The index is matched by an AddJournalChargeItem rule when the Customer's .ttstats file is processed by [TMSS10LogStatsProcess](#).



Do not add Journal Entries by editing the Journal database file directly. Entries must be submitted through a supported TapeTrack application so that the Framework Server can validate and write them correctly.
