

Setting TapeTrack License

When initially installed, the TapeTrack Framework Server will allow up to 100 [Volumes](#). This allows you to view and trial the TapeTrack software in a fully functioning version limited only by volume capacity.

To add more than 100 Volumes, you will need upgrade your TapeTrack license.

License options are:

- **Temporary license:** A temporary license key will allow you to operate the TapeTrack Software without restriction other than 12 day expiry date, this mode of licensing is reserved for those evaluating the TapeTrack Software or those needing a license expiry extension in an emergency situation. Obtaining a Temporary License requires TapeMaster installed on a computer with internet access.
- **Trial License:** A 90 day trial license allows a fully functional installation of TapeTrack to evaluate the software to ensure it is the correct tool to manage your backup volumes.
- **Permanent License:** A permanent license key will allow you to operate the TapeTrack software without restriction until the expiry date associated with your license occurs. Permanent license/s to TapeTrack are restricted to those who have a written End User License Agreement (EULA) with GazillaByte.
