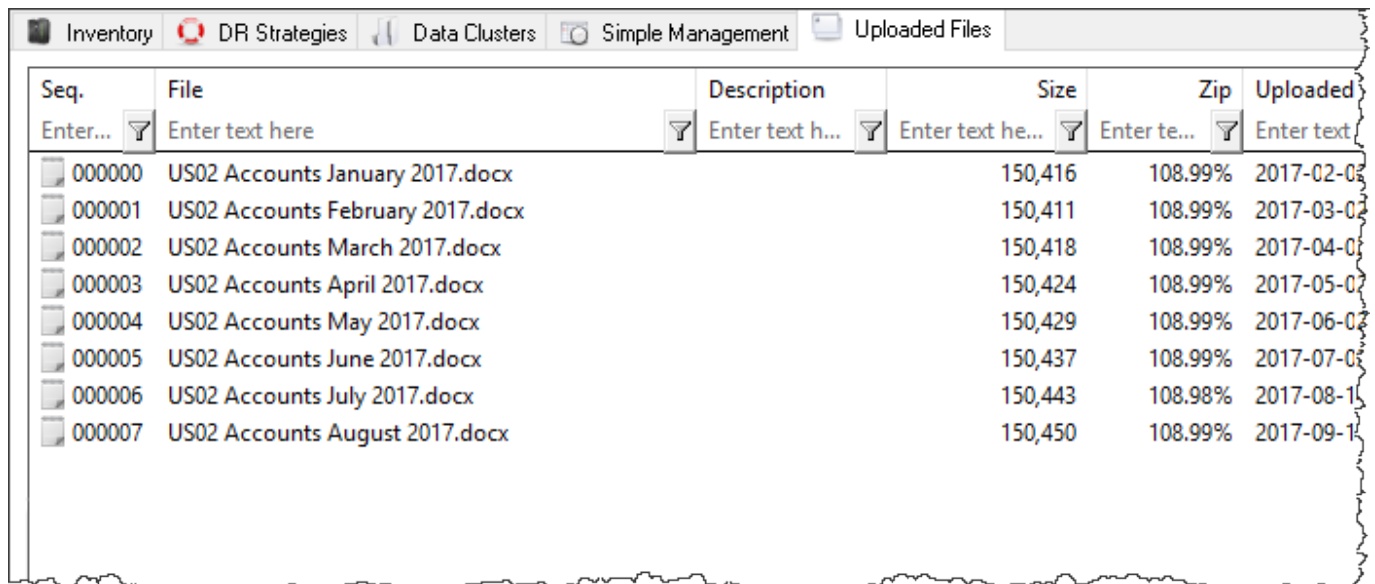


Upload Files Tab

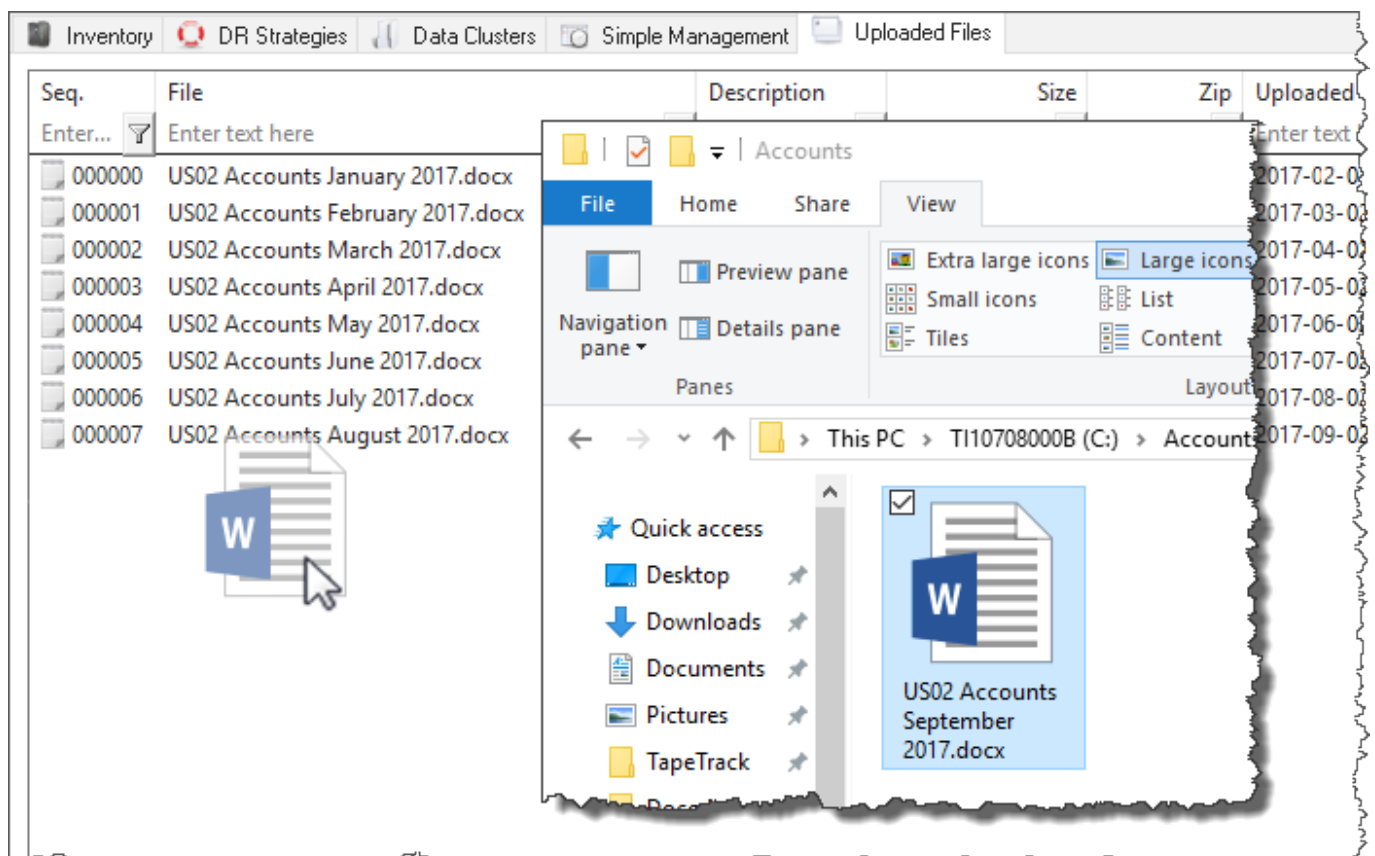
The **Uploaded Files Tab** provides an interface for uploading and downloading files to and from the TapeTrack Server so that they can be accessed by any TapeTrack Client connecting to the selected [Customer](#).

Uploading Files

To add files to the Uploaded Files tab, drag and drop the files from Windows Explorer into the Uploaded Files tab window.



Right-Click Functions

Right-clicking in the Uploaded Files Tab provides three options:

- Delete: Deletes the selected files.
- Properties: Displays details pertaining to the selected file.
- Download: Downloads the selected file to your computer.
