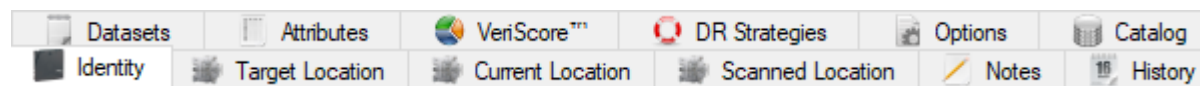


Volume Properties Window

The **Volume Properties Window** contains information and administrative controls for each individual **Volume**. It can be accessed by right-clicking on a **Volume** in the **Volume List** and selecting Properties or by double-clicking a **Volume** in the **Volume List**.



There are twelve tabs in the Volume Properties Window. They are as follows:

1. **Identity:** Displays the **Customer-ID**, **Media-ID** and **Volume-ID** for the selected **Volume**.
2. **Target Location:** Displays the Repository and **Slot** that a **Volume** is moving to if it is in a **Move**. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the same as the Current Location.
3. **Current Location:** Displays the **Repository** and **Slot** where a Volume was last confirmed. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the **Repository** that the **Volume** is from.
4. **Scanned Location:** Displays the **Repository** and **Slot** where a **Volume** was last scanned or confirmed. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the **Repository** that the **Volume** is from.
5. **Notes:** Displays Notes about the selected **Volume**.
6. **History:** Displays all transactions that have occurred with the selected **Volume**, including Date, Time, **Repository** moved from, and **Repository** moved to.
7. **Datasets:** Displays a list of Datasets associated with the selected **Volume**.
8. **Attributes:** Used to set Attributes for a selected **Volume**.
9. **VeriScore™:** Displays VeriScore™ information for each **Volume**.
10. **DR Strategies:** Displays which **Disaster Recovery Strategies** a **Volume** is associated with.
11. **Options:** Provides a list of configuration options for each **Volume**.
12. **Catalog:**

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
