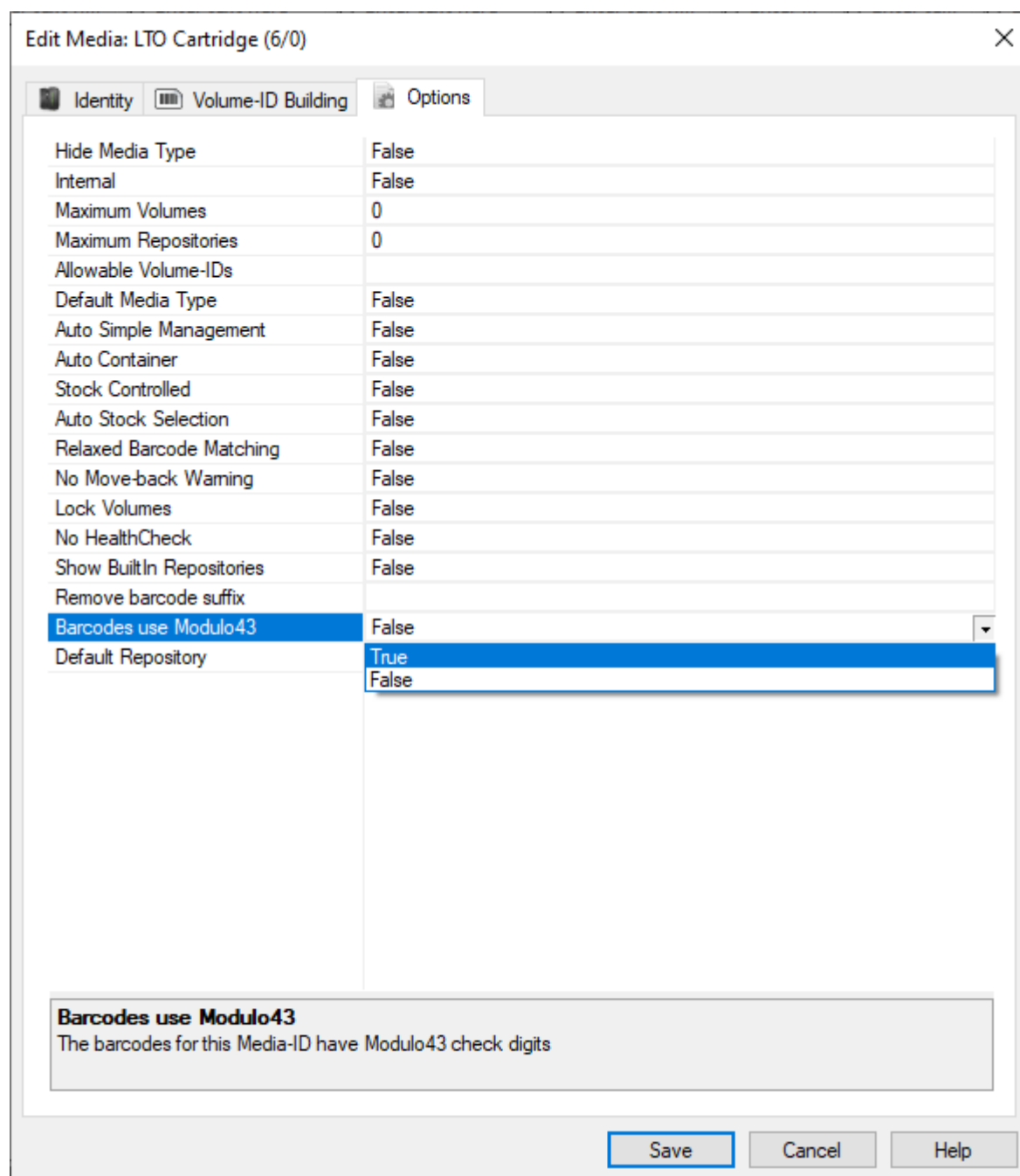


Barcodes Use Modulo43

The [Media](#) Option Barcodes Use Modulo43 checks scanned [Volume-ID's](#) for a Modulo43 check digit. If the barcode is verified as [Modulo43](#), the check digit is removed before entry into TapeTrack. If the barcode does not qualify as a [Modulo43](#) barcode, it is entered into TapeTrack without modification.
