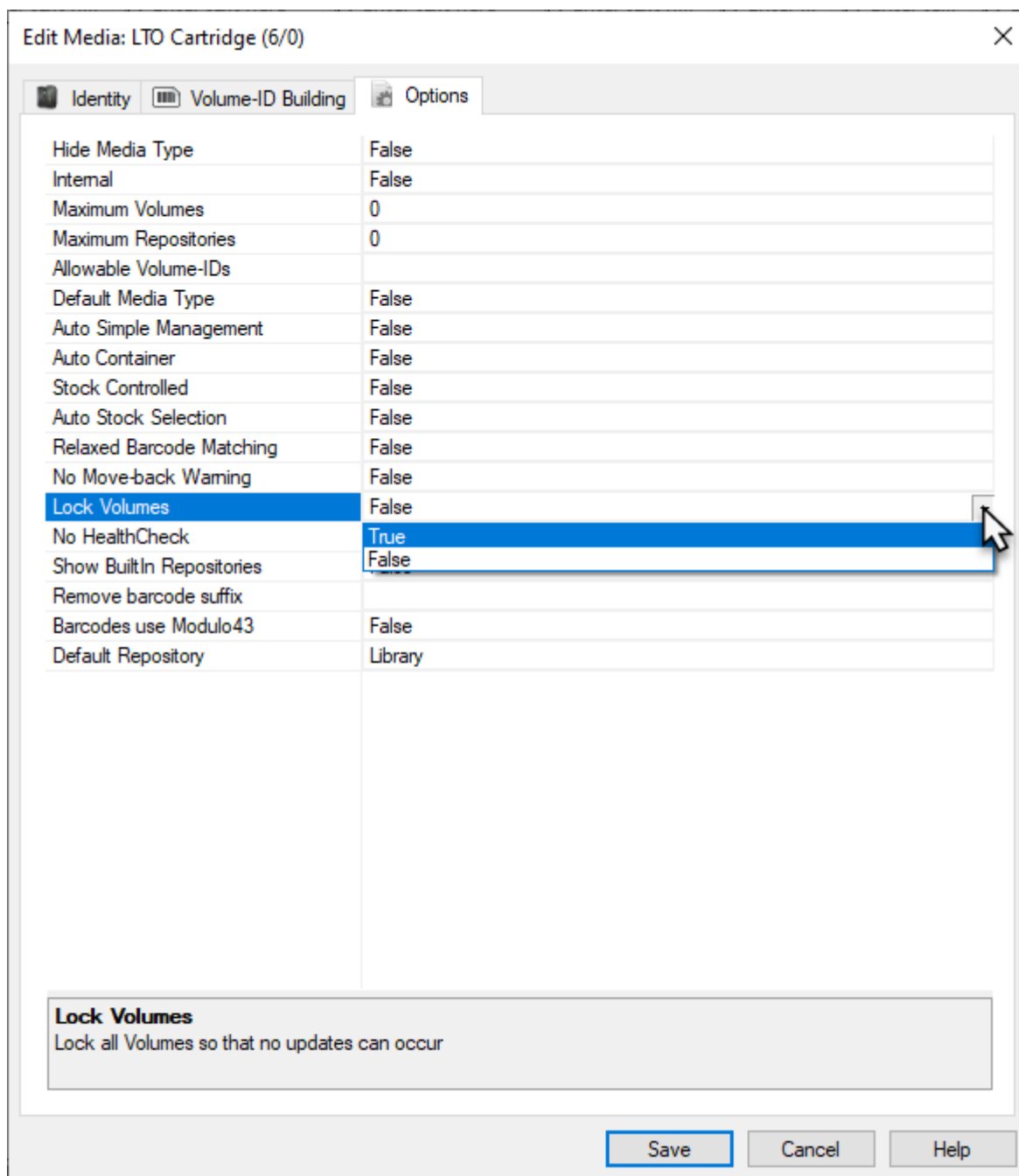


Lock Volumes
