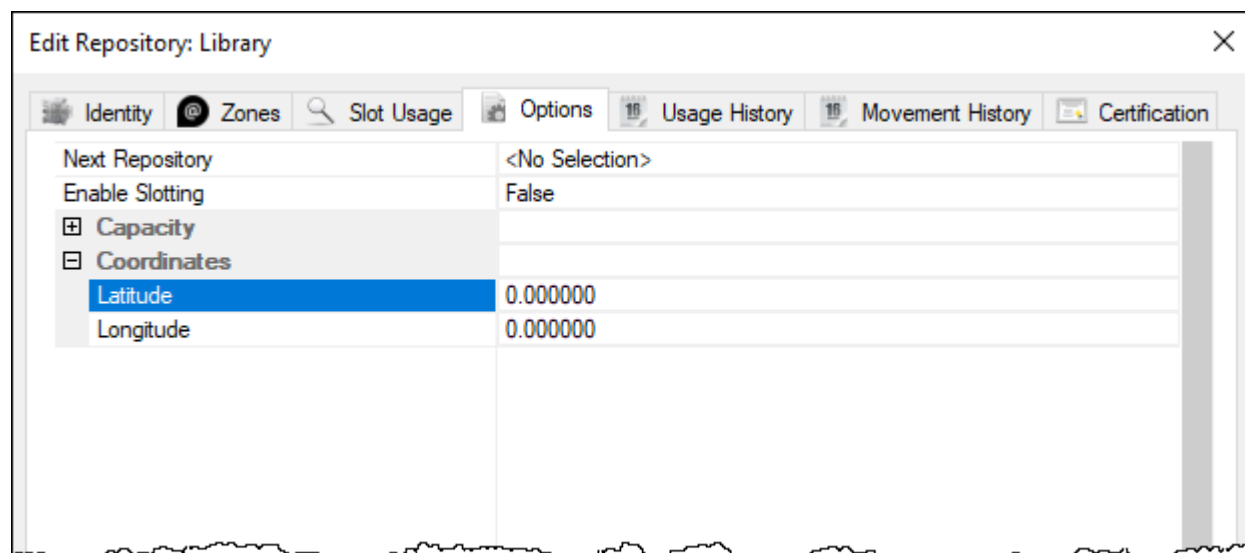


Repository Option: Coordinates
