

Disable The Replication Subsystem

The embedded database used by TapeTrack uses transactional protection. This means that as updates are applied to the underlying database, they are first written to a log file.

Disabling the replication subsystem will allow the database to automatically remove any log files that are no longer active.

Disable The Replication Subsystem Via TMSS10ServerHelper

Open the ServerHelper by navigating to your TapeTrack install directory and double clicking the file TMSS10ServerHelper.exe, located at \TapeTrack\TapeTrack Framework Server.

As the program needs registry access to make any changes, you will receive a popup requesting application permissions. Click Yes to continue or No to close. If you do not give permissions for the application to run, you will need to edit the Registry directly to make the required changes (See next section).
