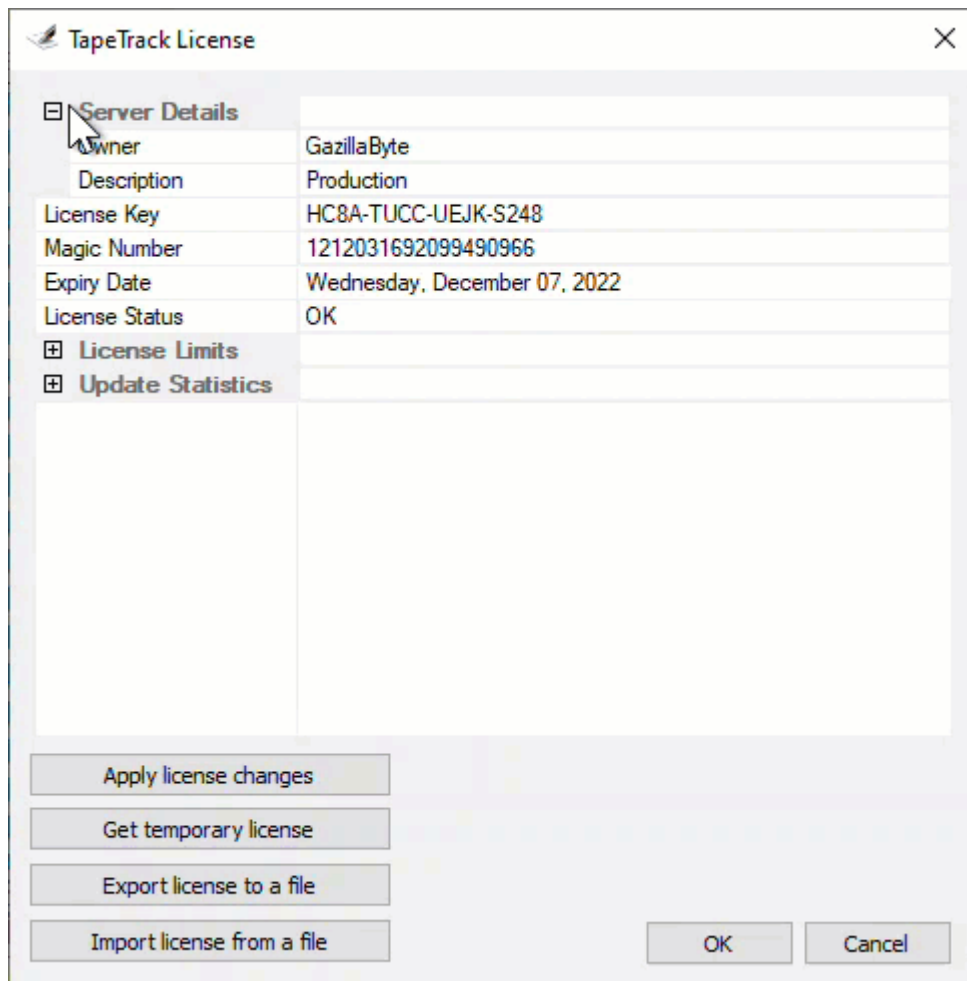

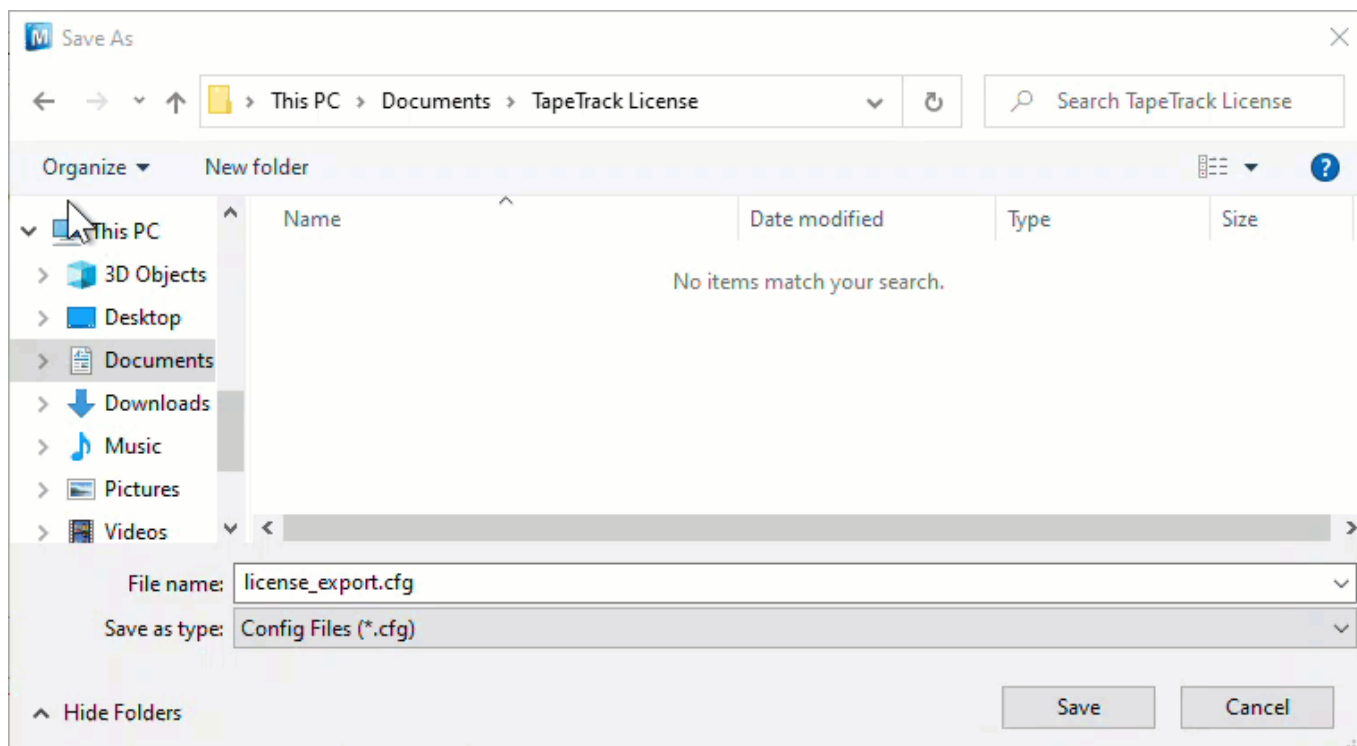


If the menu option **Framework Server Licensing** is greyed out and inaccessible, you do not have sufficient privileges (tapemaster rights) to alter the software license
