

# TMSSSDROPREPORT

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSSDROPREPORT allows you to drop, or remove, a report section from command line report output based on the report ID. This can be of benefit if you only need one section of the report output.

TMSSSDROPREPORT is used in the format TMSSSDROPREPORT + the Report-ID, so for Report 100 the variable would be TMSSSDROPREPORT100.

New Variables can be set for multiple report sections based on the Report-ID's, for example Reports 100 and 110 you would set TMSSSDROPREPORT100 and TMSSSDROPREPORT110.

## Example

### Windows Command Line

```
<sxh> set TMSSSDROPREPORT110=true </sxh>
```

### Windows PowerShell

```
<sxh> $env:TMSSSDROPREPORT110 = "true" </sxh>
```
